Chance founding artist Casey Long returns again in the director's chair, having helmed each of the prior Chance productions. "I love returning to this show every couple of years," said director Casey Long. "The bond between the sisters and Marmee is something that resounds with audiences today just as much as it did when it was first published. The show is epic in scope, involving many different love stories that involve this very devoted family. And to bring the show back to our intimate theater, just makes it all the more personal for anyone watching it."

However, this year also marks the return of another past "Little Women" artist – Sarah Pierce, who had previously appeared as "Young Amy March" when she was only 12 years old back in 2009. After appearing in many Chance shows since (including last year's OC premiere of "Edges" – for which she was nominated for an OC Theatre Guild Award – and 2019's *LA Times* Critic's Choice production of "Ragtime"), Sarah returns to play the central role of Jo March, which she describes as a "dream come true."

"I am so excited to be taking on the dream role of Jo March," Sarah Pierce said. "Jo has been a dream role for me ever since I appeared as Young Amy at the Chance. I love how she is unapologetically herself, fiercely loyal and loving and fantastically determined. 'Little Women' and Jo have so much heart. It is a very special experience to be returning to this show as the Chance has been an integral part of my artistic development and expression for as long as I can remember. I am so, so thankful to be performing this beautiful story about sisterhood and family at a place I have always called home."

Joining Long and Maldonado on the creative team are production designer **Masako Tobaru** ("Striking 12," Chance Theater Resident Artist), costume designer **Carole Zelinger** ("Samsara"), and stage manager **Jordan Jones** ("Anne of Green Gables").

Joining Pierce in the cast are **Emily Abeles** ("Anne of Green Gables") as Beth, **Katherine Chatman** (Chance Debut) as Meg, **Camie Del Rosario** (Chance Debut) as Amy, **Maggie Randolph** (Chance Debut) as Marmee, **Zac Swan Van Lent** (Chance Debut) as Laurie, **Tucker Boyes** ("The Secret Garden, The Musical") as Professor Bhaer, **Jennifer Sparks** (Chance Debut) as Aunt March, **Christopher Diem** ("Green Day's American Idiot," Chance Theater Resident Artist) as John Brooke, and **Glenn Koppel** ("Ragtime") as Mr. Laurence.
