Based on the novel Ragtime by E. L. Doctorow, *Ragtime: The Musical* is written by Terrence McNally, and composed by Stephen Flaherty with lyrics by Lynn Ahrens. This production is directed by Casey Stangl, with choreography by Kelly Todd, and music direction by Robyn Manion. *Ragtime: The Musical* will now run for an additional two weeks through August 11th on the Cripe Stage at the Bette Aitken *theater arts* Center.
